Description:	<p>Fix a silly bug in xconfig.sh, when it tries to look up the card id from lspci in the 96xx_supported.tx file it uses **grep**, but should be using **grep -i**, since lspci reports the hex numbers in lower case and the file lists them in upper case. I'll submit a fix as soon as I finish testing it.</p> <p>I've marked this medium, since it prevents the script from using the legacy nvidia drivers when it should it, and there are a lot of folks out there using these cards.</p>
