

## LinHES - Bug # 163: popup status window uses a suboptimal part of the main background

<b>Description:</b>	<p>In git HEAD version I just built, the default installer theme now says LinHES in the background, which is cool, but the popup status window for network detection (and possibly other things) displays a truncated portion of the background that contains part of the first few letters of LinHES.</p> <p>Possible remedies:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) If MythUI (or whatever is appropriate) can be told where to pull background images for popup windows, tell it to pull from the center of the background.</li><li>2) Move the LinHES text to somewhere other than the top.</li><li>3) Move the LinHES text so that it looks right in the portion of the background that it used for popup status windows.</li></ol>
