<b>Description:</b>	<p>I went under Service Menu&gt;LinHES Configuration&gt;Advanced Settings and enabled "Windows sharing" both "share media" and "share home." After about 5 min, I got dropped back to the Service Menu, but as far as I can tell, samba did not start.
