<b>Description:</b>	pacman -Syu is broken in 6.00.06 for systems which require the older nvidia drivers. This is because the mythtv package has apparently been superseded by the mythtv-udpau package which requires the beta drivers which do not work with older cards. The bug is in the current state of the package repository rather than the ISO.

MythTV hasn't been superseded. If asked, and you don't have a VDPAU capable card, you shouldn't asked yes to mythtv-udpau.
