Description:	I don't know if this is intentional or not, but I think this will cause a lot of confusion if it is left like this. In /etc/rc.conf there is a variable DAEMONS that lists daemons (in /etc/rc.d) to start up on boot. However, these are not started. I believe that /etc/rc.sysinit should be modified to start these daemons. See /etc/rc.multi for an example of how this should be done.
