Description:	<p>An update today reminded me of this issue. If one is using a serial remote control, the run script for lircd has an error:</p> <pre>/usr/bin/setserial /dev/serial_port uart none</pre> <p>should be</p> <pre>/usr/bin/setserial /dev/\$serial_port uart none</pre> <p>It's using a static "/dev/serial_port" string instead of the "\$serial_port" variable.</p> <p>The module loaded after this command is "lirc_serial". Probably 99% of the time this is correct. However some serial IR receivers (like mine) need the "lirc_sir" module.</p> <p>Perhaps a solution is to add another /etc/systemconfig property where this driver can be set and the lircd/run script uses it like other properties it currently uses.</p>
