Description:	The NFS client in R6 intermittently hangs when accessing an NFS share. I have not found a reliable way to		
	reproduce this, but it does happen a couple of times a day to NFS shares listed in /etc/fstab. The only way I found to recover from this problem besides rebooting is to stop the frontend and use umount -f on the NFS		
	shares on the client. This does not always	s work.	
	Using AutoFS decreases the frequency of the problem, but is by no means, a fix.		
	The NFS server has been in use for years and has no problem with any of the other clients that are using it.		
	I've changed the switch, and the cables between the server and the client to no effect.		
	This happens on several different clients, and is experienced by other users as seen in the original post.

	This bug makes sharing pictures, videos, and music from a central server almost impossible.		
	It also makes a slave backend unreliable.
