

LinHES - Bug # 705: Upgrade script assumes that it is run in xterm

| Description: | <p>I was browsing through the recent upgrade script for 6.03 (upgrade_linhes.sh) and noticed in one section (where it starts the schema upgrade) that it tries to open an xterm. I expect this to throw an error and potentially fail the script if you are executing from ssh or similar.</p> <p>A suggestion would be to check the terminal type and if this is not being run from X then the script should instead say something like "you appear to be doing this from a terminal window, open another terminal and verify that the backend has completed its upgrades by monitoring /var/log/mythtv/mythbackend.log"</p> <p>In the forum, I noted girkers also tripped on this by accident as the warning doesn't happen until the schema upgrade already began.</p> | | |
