While we were chatting the daily backup process started running. At 9:45pm. This is a script that was in the /etc/cron.daily folder. From what I gather, things in the cron.daily folder should run at midnight. In doing some searching, I am guessing that this is due to a known issue with dcron 4-4.2 as found in this bug report: <a href="https://bugs.archlinux.org/task/18681">https://bugs.archlinux.org/task/18681</a> . Supposedly this has been fixed in the 4.5 release.</p> <p>Since I see that there aren't any cron alternatives in the standard LinHES repos, is there any chance the version of dcron will be updated?</p>
