<b>Description:</b>	<p>When starting the frontend using alt-m mythfrontend-start never exits. This causes a problem for pause-mythcommflag.sh.</p> <p>When this command runs:</p> <pre>top -bn1u mythtv   grep mythfrontend   awk '{ print \$9 }'</pre> <p>It returns:</p> <pre>13 0</pre> <p>This causes pause-mythcommflag to get confused and hangs and causes other weird problems</p> <p>Once you kill the "/usr/LH/bin/mythfrontend-start" process all is well.</p> <pre>top -bn1u mythtv   grep mythfrontend   awk '{ print \$9 }'</pre> <p>It returns:</p> <pre>13</pre> <p>and all is well.</p>
