Description:	<p>I have just installed R8 on my FE and it has a nvidia 7600GS so naturally the installer detects that it is a nvidia card and trys to installer the driver. However once the driver is installed and the modeline then gets set the installer stops there.</p> <p>I was able to get my front-end installed using the vesa driver, however when I tried to install the nvidia driver the system only has the current 310 driver available.</p> <p>Could you please make the installer smarter, this page has the codes you need to check which version of the driver to use, https://wiki.archlinux.org/index.php/NVIDIA</p>
